Budgetary Quotations and Pricing Accuracy

Guidelines for Projects with Incomplete, Evolving, or Preliminary Plans

Purpose of This Procedure

LinearLED provides quotations based on the information available at the time of estimation. The accuracy of any quotation depends directly on the completeness and clarity of the plans and project information provided.

In most cases, a budgetary quotation is sufficient. Once the project is ready, LinearLED performs final site measurements and invoices only the products and services ultimately supplied and/or installed.

For projects completed in multiple phases, measurements, production, installation, and invoicing may also occur in phases as different areas become ready.

The accuracy of a budgetary quotation is largely dependent on the information provided. For example:

- Plans with clearly identified LED locations, elevations, dimensions, and load information generally result in highly accurate quotations.
- Preliminary, incomplete, or evolving plans may result in greater variation between the original estimate and the final invoice.

Clients who are comfortable proceeding based on a budgetary estimate and being invoiced according to the final scope of work generally do not need to refer to the remainder of this document.

The following procedure applies primarily to projects where greater pricing certainty is required prior to construction completion.

Project Coordination and Design Responsibility

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, LinearLED's role is limited to supplying, manufacturing, and/or installing LED lighting systems based on information provided by the project team.

While LinearLED may provide recommendations regarding product selection, installation methods, controls, power requirements, and system integration, final design decisions remain the responsibility of the client and/or their designated project representatives.

Where significant design assistance, project coordination, consultation, or ongoing involvement is required beyond the scope of a standard quotation, additional fees may apply.

1. Plan Revisions

One or two quotation revisions are typically accommodated at no additional charge, provided all changes are clearly identified on the updated plans or documents submitted.

Clients are responsible for clearly indicating any changes affecting the LinearLED scope of work, including revised locations, dimensions, quantities, lighting requirements, or other modifications impacting the quotation.

When updated plans are submitted without clearly identifying revisions, or when extensive comparison between plan versions is required, LinearLED reserves the right to charge for the additional review and coordination time required.

2. Coordination Meetings

For larger or more complex projects involving multiple trades, ongoing design development, or project details that have not yet been fully defined, we highly recommend a coordination meeting to clarify project requirements.

Additional coordination and consultation fees may apply.

3. Responsibility for Provided Information

The client, designer, contractor, or other responsible party must provide current and sufficiently detailed information to allow for accurate project evaluation.

Omissions or inaccurate information affecting dimensions, quantities, locations, controls, power requirements, installation methods, or other aspects of the project may result in price adjustments and additional charges.
